The irony is that very few resources are devoted to this precious population. We already knew what the experts are now finding out, that what an unaccompanied homeless woman wants most is a sense of belonging. At WISEPlace we provide that sense of having a place where one can call home both now and in the future.


Many women who come to WISEPlace face a multitude of barriers to immediate successful independent living. These barriers include ongoing trauma from abuse or other dysfunctional family dynamics, gaps in employment, substance abuse, and incarceration. Another huge hurdle is finding an affordable and safe place to live permanently in the expensive Orange County market. WISEPlace knows that there are no quick fixes and we make a commitment to the women we serve to provide that base of support that they need now and in the future.

WISEPlace is working within the continuum of care in Orange County to determine how we best support the overall goal of quickly moving families to permanent housing in Orange County while maintaining the integrity of the very important niche we fill in our community.

We continue to weigh our options regarding funding and aggressively seek new avenues of support as some of the traditional funders have moved away from comprehensive transitional programs. On the other hand, we see entities and agencies looking to WISEPlace to provide our services to a broader audience.

During the course of the past year two of our board members elected to leave the board due to other pressing business and personal obligations. We thank Kimberly Kepler and Radhika Dholakia for your service will on the board. We especially thank the current and former board members who remain committed to finding ways for WISEPlace to continue to make a difference in the lives of unaccompanied homeless women.

This is a time of transition and we are encouraged and excited that the change will be very good for us!

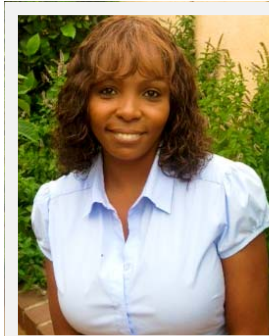

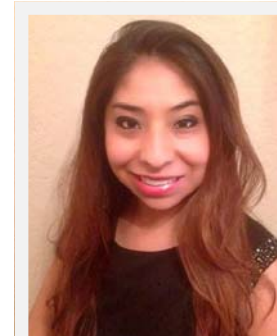

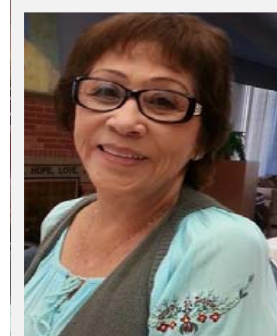

## Steps to Independence

The Steps to Independence Program provided a home for 90 women last year, when they needed it the most. Women find themselves homeless for many different reasons; some have endured a catastrophic financial set-back, others have struggled with alcohol or substance abuse and chronic homelessness. For our youngest women, turning 18 meant that they were emancipated from the only home they had.

The “Steps” program provides safe and affordable housing, employment assistance, case management, financial literacy training, healthy meals, clothing, individual and group psychological counseling, and linkages to the community. WISEPlace has helped over 7, 000 women over the past 28 years.

## Financial Empowerment

Our Financial Empowerment Program teaches women basic financial literacy. Our program starts with employment and ends after the successful transition into housing. WISE Beginnings, is our internship program for women with barriers to employment. Women that complete our program know how to compete in today’s job market, create and live by a budget, save for the future, and have realistic housing goals.

## Positive Step

Our Positive Step Program is a second step home that helps women that have been chronically homeless or at risk of homelessness build upon their success in the Steps to Independence Program. Women can use additional time to work through the conditions that led to homelessness in their life. With a focus on health, wellness, and stability, the Positive Step program helps remove longstanding barriers to independent living. Last year, 100 % of women that completed the program moved to permanent housing.

## Rapid Re-Housing

For women already homeless, we work to significantly reduce the length of time they remain in a homeless state. This program works with the community at-large, and continues our proud tradition of meeting the most pressing needs of women in our community.

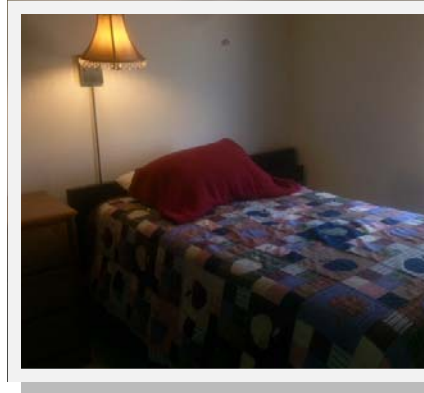

## Single Room Occupancy (SRO) Program

For women who do not need a full 6 month program, but need a place to regroup while finding permanent housing, we offer our SRO program. The women in this program stay up to 3 months in a single occupancy room with bath and they have fewer program requirements, but are welcome to access all aspects of our Steps program. They pay fees (rent) on a monthly rather than weekly basis.

# ACHIEVING INDEPENDENCE

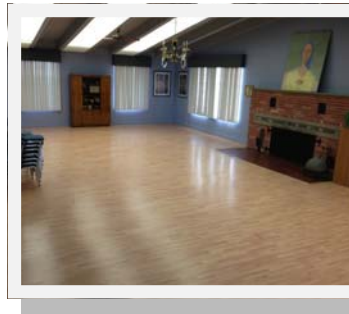
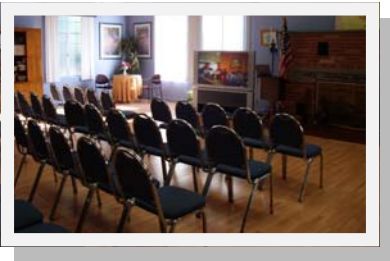
Chan is 33 years old and came from a marriage in which she suffered mental and physical abuse. When she came to WISEPlace, her slender body still bore the marks of the abuse. Her husband also sexually abused her throughout their marriage. She had no family or nearby relatives for immediate support, all her family members live in Asia. Her husband would only allow her to go to work and then straight home. He did not allow her to have friends, he controlled their finances and monitored her limited spending. His parents, with whom they lived, were participants in the abuse as well.

Her husband was sponsoring her citizenship and threatened to have her deported if she left him. But she finally bravely called a domestic violence shelter, packed her belongings in her car and left. She suffered severe depression from the spousal abuse, and she was also very angry about the pain inflicted by her husband. After being in hiding in the domestic violence shelter, she came to WISEPlace. WISEPlace program staff and volunteers along with her Turning Point Counselor worked with her to get her to a point where she could function, look for a job and begin her healing path to self-sufficiency. With assistance, Chan began the legal divorce process and investigated her immigration rights. With the depression and anger properly addressed, she landed a good paying job in accounting, saved money, and has now moved into permanent housing. Chan's journey continues, but thanks to the unique WISEPlace combination of nurture and personal accountability, she is now on her way to long-term self-sufficiency.
