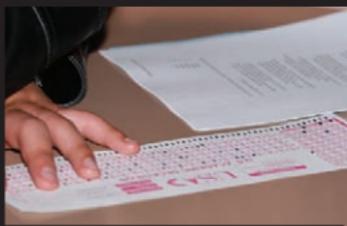

What Is the Orange County Academic Decathlon (OCAD)?

Like its ancient Greek counterpart, Academic Decathlon is a ten event contest where A, B, and C-level high school students work as teams to compete in the areas of language and literature, science, mathematics, social science, economics, art, music, essay, interview, and speech.

The competition culminates with an exciting Super Quiz relay, a team event where parents and classmates cheer from the sidelines, much like a sporting event. Each team aspires to compete at the state or national level.

Students report that Academic Decathlon supports their academic growth while helping them find a sense of belonging and the self-confidence to pursue a future they may not have imagined.

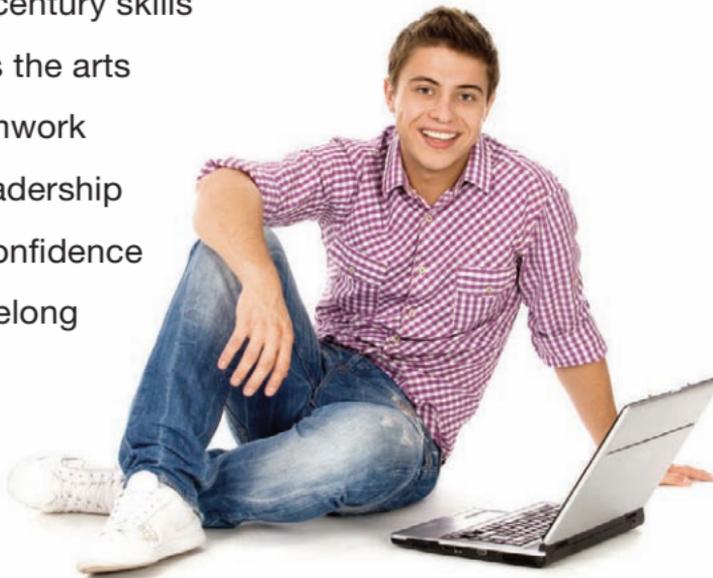

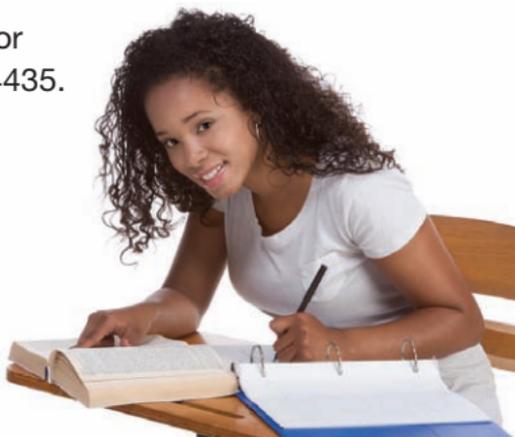
